- EVENT NO. 1      QUALIFICATIONS—Two laps to be run consecutively with the faster counting as official qualifying time.
- EVENT NO. 2      10 LAP HEAT RACE—Cars qualifying 1, 4, 7, 10, 13, 16, 19, 22, 25, 28 and 31 starting with the fastest 8 cars starting inverted. Cars finishing 1 through 5 will start in Event No. 6. Cars finishing 6 through the balance will start in Event No. 5.
- EVENT NO. 3      10 LAP HEAT RACE—Cars qualifying 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, 17, 20, 23, 26, 29 and 32 starting with the fastest 8 cars starting inverted. Cars finishing 1 through 5 will start in Event No. 6. Cars finishing 6 through the balance will start in Event No. 5.
- EVENT NO. 4      10 LAP HEAT RACE—Cars qualifying 3, 6, 9, 12, 15, 18, 21, 24, 27 and 30 starting with the fastest 8 cars starting inverted. Cars finishing 1 through 5 will start in Event No. 6. Cars finishing 6 through the balance will start in Event No. 5.
- EVENT NO. 5      12-LAP SEMI—Cars finishing 6 through the balance in Events 2 through 4. All cars start straight up by official qualification times. Cars finishing 1 through 7 will start in Event No. 6.
- EVENT NO. 6      40-LAP FEATURE—22 starters: Cars finishing 1 through 5 in Events 2 through 4 and cars finishing 1 through 7 in Event No. 5 starting straight up by official qualification times, with the exception that the fastest six (6) cars transferring from Events 2 through 4 shall be inverted.

- SFI approved roll cage nets are required on both sides of cars not utilizing a USAC approved full containment seats.
