- Only properly licensed entrants and drivers will earn championship points and share in the point fund.

PROGRAM OF EVENTS

- EVENT NO. 1 QUALIFICATIONS—Two laps to be run consecutively with the faster counting as official qualifying time.
- EVENT NO. 2 QUALIFYING RACE—SEE INSIDE FOR DETAILS
- EVENT NO. 3 10 LAP HEAT RACE—8 starters: Cars qualifying 1, 5, 9, 13, 17, 21, 25 and 29 starting in inverted order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start in Event No. 8. Cars finishing 5 through 8 will start in Event No. 7.
- EVENT NO. 4 10 LAP HEAT RACE—8 starters: Cars qualifying 2, 6, 10, 14, 18, 22, 26 and 30 starting in inverted order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start in Event No. 8. Cars finishing 5 through 8 will start in Event No. 7.
- EVENT NO. 5 10 LAP HEAT RACE—8 starters: Cars qualifying 3, 7, 11, 15, 19, 23, 27 and 31 starting in inverted order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start in Event No. 8. Cars finishing 5 through 8 will start in Event No. 7.
- EVENT NO. 6 10 LAP HEAT RACE—8 starters: Cars qualifying 4, 8, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28 and 32 starting in inverted order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start in Event No. 8. Cars finishing 5 through 8 will start in Event No. 7.
- EVENT NO. 7 12-LAP SEMI FEATURE—16 starters: Cars finishing 5 through 8 in Events 3 through 6. All cars start straight up by official qualification times. Cars finishing 1 through 6 will start in Event No. 8.
- EVENT NO. 8 30-LAP FEATURE—22 starters: Cars finishing 1 through 4 in Events 3 through 6 and cars finishing 1 through 6 in Event No. 7 starting straight up by official qualification times, with the exception that the fastest six (6) cars shall be inverted.

Heat Races at Terre Haute will be 8 Laps.

QUALIFYING RACES

When the total number of cars qualified is 37 or more, a Qualifying Race may be held for cars qualifying 33 and higher, starting straight up by qualification order. Cars finishing 1 through 4 will start behind qualified cars in the heats. Added Heat Race starters from the "Qualifying Race" are eligible for the Semi Feature and will line up according to the official qualification time.

When the total number of qualified cars is 48 or more a second qualifying race will be held. Cars qualifying in odd numbers starting with 33 will comprise qualifying race #1. Cars qualifying in even numbers starting with 34 will comprise qualifying race #2. Starting position will be based on qualifying starting straight up. Qualifying race winners and 2nd place finishers will start 9th in heat races, finishers 3rd and 4th will start 10th. These cars will also be eligible for the semi feature and will start according to qualifying time.

PIT CREDENTIALS

Members agree to pay \$25.00 per entrant, \$25.00 per driver and \$25.00 per each crew member.

Non-Members will pay \$30.00

Provisional Starters

The provisional starter program will be in effect for this series. TWO (2) provisionals per event will be awarded to National Series Entrants who are in the Top 20 in the 2009 season entrant point standings, if eligible.

The two highest ranking USAC/CRA Sprint Car Drivers who are in the top 20 in USAC/CRA Driver Points as of July 8, 2009 will be offered a provisional starting position behind the USAC National Cars. There will be a limit of 2 provisionals per Driver for Indiana Sprint Week.

- ▶ **Rock Screens & Quiet Mufflers are mandatory at Bloomington & Lawrenceburg.**
- ▶ **1-Way Radios MANDATORY**
- ▶ **SFI Approved Roll Cage Nets REQUIRED on BOTH sides of cars not utilizing USAC approved full containment seats!**
- ▶ **All Owners & Drivers that are not USAC Members must fill out a TP to receive a prize money check.**
- ▶ **All cars must race a Hoosier DT-3 or Hard/F55 tire on the right rear. All cars must have clearly legible numbers and be distinctively recognizable by scoring personnel.**
- ▶ **To be eligible to earn Indiana Sprint Week points Owners & Drivers must have a National Sprint Car License or a Sprint Week License.**
- ▶ **SFI approved head & neck restraint system is required.**
